*I enjoyed the opportunities to see ways that libraries apply emerging technology, as well as being able to meet other librarians.*

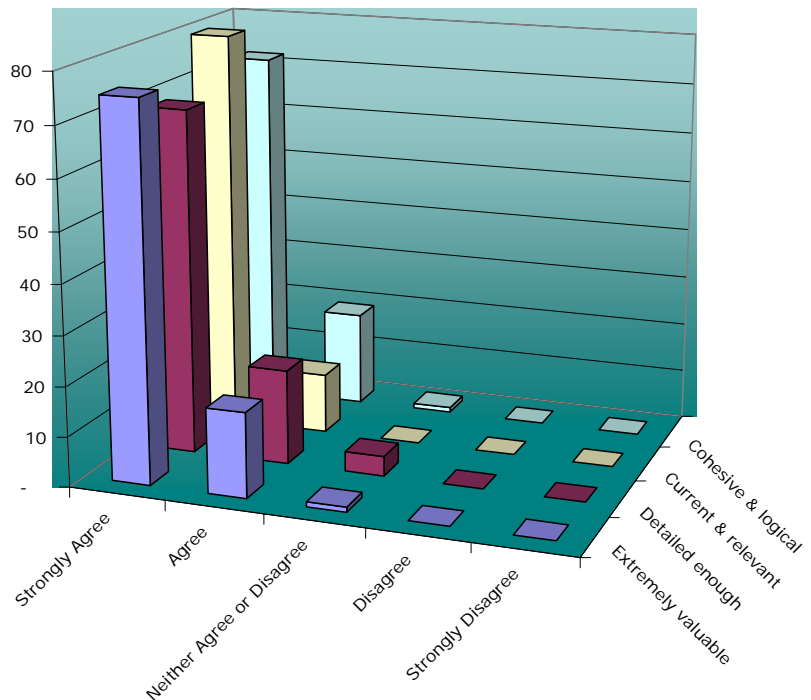
*Learned basic info about tech that I had no idea about.
